- a trauma-informed approach to discussing difficult topics

Standard trainings include:

SA 101: Dynamics of Sexual Violence

How to Support Survivors: Trauma-informed, Survivor-centered Care

Taking disclosures, navigating mandated reporting, and creating practices that respect bodily autonomy.

- trauma-informed pedagogy (for educators)
